

Anderson Arts Center Camp Safety Protocol (COVID-19)

- **Each camper, staff member and volunteer will have a temperature check upon entering the building.
Anyone with a temperature above 100°F will be not be allowed to stay at camp.**
- **Sign in and sign out will be in the Atrium Gallery, accessed through the main entrance, with six feet between each registrant.**
- **All classrooms will be cleaned & disinfected each day.**
- **Adequate time for handwashing will be allowed throughout the day and encouraged often.**
- **Maximum of 10 kids per age group. (three age groups total)**
- **Age groups stay with their same group throughout the day.**
- **Distanced seating for children within classrooms.**
- **Staff members and volunteers will wear masks.**
- **Whole group presentations will be held in a large gallery with ample distance between campers.**
- **Use of shared materials will be limited and materials will be disinfected regularly.**

The Department of Social Services (DSS) and the Department of Health & Environmental Control (DHEC) have worked together to develop guidelines to assist day camp providers in re-opening quickly and safely. In addition to actions specific to minimizing the spread of COVID-19, the guidelines incorporate general health and safety recommendations. The Anderson Arts Center will be in compliance with these guidelines.
