Our Juror: JOHN HARKINS



John Harkins is a visual artist whose work explores the incongruity between Catholicism and Queerness. Through collage and mixed media processes, he juxtaposes images and iconography of each. The resulting 2D and 3D works comment on his experience trying to reconcile these identities with each other.

John is a Professor of Foundation Studies at Savannah College of Art and Design. He received a Bachelor of Fine Arts degree from the University of Michigan, and a Master of Fine Arts from Wayne State

University. In addition to his experience at SCAD, John has worked as a studio instructor as well as the creative administrator for an advertising agency. When he is not teaching or working in his studio, he enjoys volunteering, and making guitar-based experimental music.

ELIGIBILITY

- Minimum 18 years old
- Only original works not previously shown at the AAC
- Must have been created within the past two years
- Any media welcome including painting, pastel, drawing, sculpture, pottery, basketry, graphic, wood, mixed media, photography, metalwork, and jewelry, etc
- All work to be hung must be appropriately and securely wired for hanging
- No clip mounting and no sawtooth hangers
- If subject to damage, must be under plexiglass or glass (gallery-wrapped canvas acceptable)
- All 3-D work must sit solidly on a flat surface or properly mounted for hanging
- No size restrictions, but MUST be transportable and able to be hung in a conventionally sized gallery

ENTRY FEE

\$40 for one OR two entries. Artist may enter more than two pieces for an additional \$40 per two pieces.

NOTIFICATION

Results will be posted online by **March 22**. No results will be given over the phone. **Results will NOT be mailed**.

AWARDS

Best in Show (\$2000), Second Place (\$1000), Third Place (\$500), Callie Stringer Rainey Award (\$1000), Merit Awards (\$100-\$250), and Purchase Awards (\$500/\$1000)

ARTWORK SALES

All entries are available for sale through the gallery unless noted. A 35% commission will be charged by the Anderson Arts Center.

PURCHASE & MERIT AWARDS

Merit awards range from \$100 to \$250. These monetary awards go directly to the artist showing that our community considers their work valuable and worthy of recognition. Donors do not receive anything in return.

A **purchase award** benefits both the artist and the award donor. Artists may select to be eligible for either a \$500 or \$1000 purchase award. For example, if a piece is priced at \$750, you can elect the \$500 purchase award option, meaning the purchase award donor may acquire the piece for \$500. The artist receives the full amount with no split in commission to the Arts Center. A piece priced at \$1300 might elect to be eligible for the \$1000 purchase award. The artist will receive \$1000 in its entirety, with no split in commission to the Arts Center. Purchase awards are selected before the show opens to the public; however, if your piece is not selected as a purchase award, it is still eligible to purchase at the original price you provide to us.

SculpTOUR

Outdoor sculpture artists are also invited to participate in the Juried Show through our SculpTOUR partnership with the City of Anderson. This competition and exhibition allows for up to six outdoor sculptures to be juried into a year-long outdoor exhibition with cash prizes of **\$1,000** each. A special sculpture selection committee will juror this artwork.

- Pieces will be installed before April 28 and must remain for one year.
- Artists chosen must be available during the installation and takedown processes.

Installation costs and insurance is the responsibility of the Anderson Arts Center.

ART ON THE TOWN

Art on the Town is an extended exhibit of the Juried Show. Works are eligible for Art on the Town if indicated on the entry form. Artwork will be on view in various restaurants, retail shops, and other business locations from **April 28 - May 12**. You must check the Art on the Town box on the entry card to be eligible.

HOW TO ENTER

How to Enter Juried Show*

- 1. Visit www.AndersonArts.org
- 2. Click Juried Show button on home page
- 3. Submit entry form and payment online (\$40 for two entries)
- 4. Fill out and attach the Identification Cards to your pieces (included on this mailer).
- 5. Drop off your entries at the Anderson Arts Center March 9-11

*If you prefer to pay in person, you may submit your entry card and payment when delivering works.

How to Enter SculpTOUR

- 1. Visit www.AndersonArts.org
- 2. Click SculpTOUR button on home page.
- 3. Submit entry form (photos, dimensions, etc.) and payment online (\$40 for a maximum of two entries).

4. Jurying will be based on photos provided, so be prepared to submit 3-5 photos of each piece.
