Bay3 Artisan Gallery is a co-operative gallery of local artists. When space allows we are extremely interested in attracting new partners - jewelry designers, potters or sculptors are encouraged, as well as two dimensional artists. If you would like to submit your work for consideration, you may do so by sending photographic examples of your work (preferable by email) and completed application to: diannsimms@att.net.

It is very important that you read the following carefully: Being a Partner means a commitment of your time and talent, and it is important that you fully understand your responsibilities. New Partners become a part of a co-operative arrangement with the Anderson Arts Center. There is a non-refundable fee of \$175 each year, you must be a member of the Anderson Arts Center (at least the Individual level) yearly and contribute a piece of work to the annual art auction (held in the fall). There are other monetary and time commitments as may be necessary in the promotion of the gallery. **The term of the arrangement is one year** unless it is mutually agreed upon to extend the term or to terminate. All artwork displayed must be suitable for the community and satisfactory and/or safe for display. The Partner provides original artwork that is maintained in the gallery and is accounted in an inventory stating price and other information. Original artwork is “created directly and personally by a particular artist; not a copy or imitation.” Should such pieces/studies be displayed they must clearly state ‘In the manner of...’and name the original artist. The only exception would be clearly marked duplications or prints of his or her own original artwork.

The Partner must adhere to the work schedule, be responsible for exchanging dates with another Partner, be on time and work the full schedule for the day. The Partners work at other times as necessary or desirable by the co-operative or the Arts Center. The partner understands that the Arts Center will take a 35% commission on all sales of the Partner’s work, and pay the Partner the proceeds. All partners are responsible for keeping tract of sales. At the end of each month a Bay3 partner will compile a record of sales and submit it to the Arts Center for payment to the individual partners with sales. The Arts Center is responsible for paying all applicable sales tax on behalf of the gallery Partners. The Arts Center maintains insurance “against all risks of direct physical loss or damage to artwork exhibited” with several exceptions: war, atmospheric conditions, etc.

History - Bay3 Artisan Gallery evolved from a group of artists called Creative Connections that began meeting to critique each other’s Work over 25 Years ago. When the opportunity became available to collectively manage a gallery, space was rented at the Sullivan Shoppes (now Sullivan’s Metropolitan Grill building) through the Anderson Arts Center. When the building was sold the gallery merged with Pottery Too! - an Arts Center pottery gallery - it became known as Gallery Ten. When the Arts Center Warehouse opened, we moved into the beautiful new space we still occupy under the collective name of Bay3 Artisan Gallery.
